From *Official Notice: LCMS salary information* —

- A total of 292 full-time employees serve the LCMS.
[Note: This refers only to the International Center in St. Louis.]
- Of the 300 employees, 51 are ordained clergy.
- There are 27 ordained clergymen serving as missionaries.
[Note: Not all of these 27 are in Word and Sacrament ministry.]
- Executive officers of major legal entities (Corporate Synod, CPH, CHI, Church Extension Fund, Foundation) - Actual or Average [salary]: \$121,925.
- Executive Directors of Corporate Synod, CPS, other boards, commissions and departments and CPH VP and other officers - Actual or Average [salary]: \$122,266.
- The synodical Board of Directors are currently overseeing efforts to limit the requirement for ordained clergy in positions at the International Center in order that more pastors are available for service in parish ministry.
[Note: Some positions require that they be filled by a clergyman, thus limiting the number of clergymen available to be parish pastors. The Board of Directors is trying to limit both existing and new positions that would require clergymen to fill those offices.]

From *CTCR hears plan to form new church relations office* —

- Dr. Samuel H. Nafzger, executive director of the Synod's Commission on Theology and Church Relations (CTCR) since 1975, told the commission at its Sept. 6-7 meeting that he has decided to accept a formal request from Synodical President Gerald B. Kieschnick to head a proposed church relations branch of the president's office and the CTCR beginning next July 1.
